myasthenia gravis – G severe muscular weakness

myelin – G *myelos*, marrow (white matter of cerebrum is inside the cortex)

myoclonus – G *mys*, muscle + *klonos*, tumult

myosin – G *mys*, muscle

neocortex – L *neo*, new + *cortex*, bark (of tree), shell

neuron – G sinew, cord, nerve

nucleus – L diminutive of *nux*, nut (means either the DNA containing part of a cell or a group of neurons in the brain)

nystagmus – G *nystagmos*, nodding

occipital – L *ob* + *caput*, back of head

oculomotor – L *oculus* eye + *motorius*, moving

olfactory – L *olfactus*, sniffed

oligodendrocyte – G *oligos*, few + *dendron*, tree + *kytos*, cavity or cell

operculum – L cover (*operio*, close + diminutive *culus*)

ophthalmoscope – G *ops*, eye+ *thalamus*, chamber +*skopein*, examine

opponent – L *ob*, against + *ponere*, place

orbital – L *orbis*, circle (eye-socket)

orthodromic – G *orthos*, right + *dromos*, running

ossicle – L *ossiculum*, diminutive of *os*, bone

otic – G *otikos* from *ous*, ear

otolith – G *ous*, ear + *lithos*, stone

oxytocin – G *oxys*, sharp, swift + *tokos*, birth

paralysis – G *para*, beside + *lyein*, loosen/untie

paraphasia – G *para*, beside +*phasis*, speech

parasympathetic – G *para*, beside + *syn*, together +*patheo*, feel

paresis – G *para*, beside + *hienai*, let go/throw (a partial paralysis)

paroxysmal – G *paroxynein*, sharpen (*para*, beside + *oxys*, sharp)

patella – L small plate

pathology – G *pathos*, suffering + *logos*, word, knowledge, study

pharmacology – G *pharmakon*, drug

pharynx – G throat

phoneme – G *phonein*, speak

phonological – G *phone*, sound, voice + *logos*, word, reason

photon – G *phos*, light

photoreceptor – G *phos*, light + L *re* back + *capere*, take

phrenology – G *phren*, mind+ *logos*, study (originally *phren* meant diaphragm muscle – the seat of the heart)

physiology – G *physis*, nature (physics is the study of inanimate nature; physiology is the physics of animate nature)

pia mater – L tender mother

pineal – L *pinus*, pine(cone)

pinna – L feather

pituitary – L *pituita*, mucus (from idea that gland channeled mucus to nose)

plaque – Dutch *plakken*, patch

plasticity – G *plassein*, mold form

polysomnography – G *polys*, many + L *somnus*, sleep + G *graphein*, record

pons – L bridge

posture – L *positura*, position (*ponere*, place)

presbycusis – G *presbys*, old man + *akousis*, hearing

presbyopia – G *presbys*, old man + *ops*, eye

project – L *pro*, forward + *jacere*, throw

propagation – L *pro*, forward + *pangere*, fasten

prospective – L *pro* forward + *specere* look

sciatic – G *iskhia*, hip joint

scintillating – L *scintilla*, spark

schizophrenia – G *schizo*, split+ *phren*, mind

scotoma – G *scotos*, darkness

semantic – G *sema*, sign, omen

senile – L *senex*, old man

sensory – L *sentire*, perceive

sensitize – L *sensus*, feeling/perception

septum pellucidum – L transparent (*per*, through + *lux*, light) partition

somatosensory – G *soma*, body + L *sentire*, feel

somnambulism – L *somnus*, sleep + *ambulare*, walk

sphenoid – G *sphen*, wedge

stapes – L stirrup

stereocilium – G *stereos*, solid + L *cilium* eyelid

striatum – L grooved

substantia nigra – L black substance

sulcus – G furrow

suprachiasmatic – L *supra*, above + G *chiasm*, crossing

sympathetic – G *syn*, together + *patheo*, feel

synapse – G *syn*, together + *haptein*, clasp

synchrony – G *syn*, together + *chronos*, time

syntax – G *syn*, together + *tassein*, arrange

tectorial – L *tego*, *tectus*, cover(ed)

temporal – L *tempus*, temple

thalamus – G bed(room)

thenar – G palm (of hand)

thoracic – G *thorax*, chest

thrombosis – G *thrombos*, clot

tibia – L shin (also flute since flutes were made from animal shinbones)

tinnitus – L *tinnire*, ring

tone – G *tonos*, tension

trachea – G *trachys*, rough

transduction – L *trans*, across + *ducere*, lead

transmission – L *trans*, across + *mittere*, send

transverse – L *trans*, across + *vertere*, turn.

trichromatic – G *tri*, three + *chroma*, color

trigeminal – L *tri*, three + *geminus*, born

trochlear – G *trochileia*, pulley (the trochlear nerve innervates the superior oblique muscle, the tendon of which operates through a pulley)

tympanic – G *tympanon*, drum

ultradian – L *ultra*, more than + *dies*, day

uncus – G *onkos*, hook

utricle – L diminutive of *uter*, bag

uvula – L *uvola* diminutive of *uva*, grape

vagus – L wandering

vegetative – L *vegetatio*, grow

ventral – L *venter* belly

ventricle – L diminutive of *venter*, belly

vertebra – L *vertere*, turn (hence the jointed bones of the spine)

vesicle – L diminutive of *vesica*, bladder

vestibule – L antechamber

villus – L shaggy hair

vocal – L *vox*, voice

vowel – L *vox*, voice (through French *voyelle*)

zygoma – G *zygon*, yoke
